18 Year Old Dependent Child CA Participant

This NEWS FLASH is being issued to remind staff that an 18 year old must be a full-time student and must expect to complete their course of study before or during the month they turn 19 to be dependent child eligible for Cash Assistance (CA).

Consider the customer a full-time student when they meet either of the following:

- Full-time high school attendance as defined by the school the student is attending
- Full-time trade or technical school attendance that meets either of the following:
 - 30 hours per week including shop practice
 - 25 hours per week without shop practice

Verify ALL of the following student eligibility criteria prior to eligibility determinations:

- The date of birth of the 18 year old
- Full-time Student status as defined by the school
- Expected date of completion of the course of study

Sources of verification for full-time status and date of completion include, but are not limited to the following:

- Collateral contact with the school
- Verification of School Attendance form (FA-075)
- Participant's written statement, when documented or collateral contact verification is not available
