This NEWS FLASH is being issued to inform staff that time reverts from Daylight Saving Time (DST) to Standard Time on 11/01/15.

In states and territories that observe DST, clocks are moved back from 2:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. on 11/01/15.

DST is NOT observed in the following regions of the U.S. and its territories:

- American Samoa
- Arizona

EXCEPTION

The Navajo Nation DOES participate in DST due to its large size and location in three states. Office hours of the following FAA local offices are subject to DST:

- 315C
- 324C
- 332C
- 365C

- Guam
- Hawaii
- Puerto Rico
- Virgin Islands
