TITLE: DNAP Gross Income Standards

Summary

Programs Impacted: NA

This Policy Change Alert is being issued to inform staff that effective 10/01/15 the Disaster Nutrition Assistance Program (DNAP) Gross Monthly Income Standards are changing.

In the event of a disaster, Arizona may choose to issue emergency NA benefits using the DNAP. To operate a DNAP, a Presidential disaster declaration must be obtained.

Revision Details
