This Policy Change Alert is being issued to clarify that supplies purchased for a medical need is an allowable medical expense for Nutrition Assistance.

POLICY REFERENCE: FAA4.L07G – MEDICAL SUPPLIES

The following medical supply costs are ALLOWABLE for NA ONLY when authorized by a [U.S. medically qualified source\(g\)](#):

- Syringes
- Oxygen
- Sickroom equipment
- **Purchase of other medically necessary medical supplies**
- **Cost of or rental fees for prescribed equipment**
- The initial purchase, replacement, or repair of any of the following:
 - Dentures
 - Eyeglasses, when prescribed by an ophthalmologist or optometrist
 - Hearing Aids
 - Telephonic aids for the hearing impaired
 - Prostheses

NOTE This does not include the cost of special diets. (See [NA Medical Expenses](#))
